

Qalsody™ to require prior authorization for Medicare Advantage members starting Aug. 1

For dates of service on or after Aug. 1, 2023, the following drug will require prior authorization for Medicare Plus Blue and BCN Advantage members. This drug is a part of members' medical benefits, not their pharmacy benefits.

- Qalsody (tofersen), HCPCS code J3590

Submit prior authorization requests through the NovoLogix® online tool.

When prior authorization is required

Qalsody will require prior authorization when it is administered by a health care provider in sites of care such as outpatient facilities or physician offices and is billed in one of the following ways:

- Electronically through an 837P transaction or on a professional CMS-1500 claim form
- Electronically through an 837I transaction or using the UB04 claim form for a hospital outpatient type of bill 013x

Submit prior authorization requests through the NovoLogix tool
