

Updated reminder: Changes for in-lab sleep studies to start Oct. 9

We updated an earlier version of this communication as follows:

- In the section about dates of service on or after Oct. 9, 2023, we clarified where to submit prior authorization requests for BCN Advantage members whose providers are out of network.
- In the section about dates of service before Oct. 9, 2023, we corrected the date in the note.

Prior authorization requirements for in-lab sleep studies will change for dates of service on or after Oct. 9, 2023.

For dates of service on or after Oct. 9

- For Medicare Plus Blue members, prior authorization won't be required for in-lab sleep studies.
- For BCN Advantage members, prior authorization won't be required for in-lab sleep studies when the provider is in network for the member's plan. If the provider is out of network, prior authorization will be required. Submit prior authorization requests to BCN Utilization Management through the e-referral system.

For dates of service prior to Oct. 9

Continue to submit prior authorization requests as you do now. Specifically:

• For Medicare Plus Blue members, submit prior authorization requests to Carelon Medical Benefits Management through the Carelon ProviderPortal.

• For BCN Advantage members, submit prior authorization requests to BCN Utilization Management through the e-referral system.

You must complete the <u>sleep study questionnaire</u> in the e-referral system.

Note: Use the methods above to submit retroactive authorization requests and appeals related to dates of service before Oct. 9, 2023.
