

## Guidance and instructions for completing *NOMNC* and *DENC* forms for post-acute care stays for Medicare Advantage members

<i>Notice of Medicare Non-Coverage</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When and how to complete the <i>NOMNC</i></li> <li>• What do with the completed form</li> <li>• What else you need to do before you discharge the member</li> <li>• What's required if the member chooses to discharge before the designated day</li> <li>• What happens if a member appeals the decision to end care</li> </ul>
<i>Detailed Explanation of Non-Coverage</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When and how to complete the <i>DENC</i></li> <li>• What to do with the completed form</li> <li>• How a member can request a copy of the criteria used to make the decision to end services</li> </ul>
